

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: CE CREDITS

What is the deadline and requirement?

All brokers/salespeople renewing their license are required to complete 12 CE credits by April 30, 2019. 6 of the total 12 CE Credits must be in the Core Topic Area. 2 of the 6 Core CE Credits must be in the Ethics Topic Area. The remaining 6 CE Credits can be in Core, Ethics or Elective Topic Areas. Ethics is a subcategory of Core. To make things easier, you can think of it like this:

Requirement: 2 Ethics + 4 Core + 6 Anything = 12 CE credits

There are exemptions to this. If someone was licensed after July 1, 2018, they are exempt from this April 2019 deadline. You can find more information here: <https://www.njrealtorsace.com>

How many credits do I have already?

MCAR does not keep track of your CE credits and cannot check them for anyone. The Real Estate Commission keeps track through the PSI Database and only you can check because the login requires your license number and last four digits of your SSN.

Where can I take CE Credits?

The only live class that is still available at the MCAR office is The Short Sale From a REALTOR'S Perspective on April 17 from 2-5 pm for 3 elective credits. Agents can register online at the Academy of Continuing Education. If you need more than 3 credits, you can find live classes elsewhere or take them online.

Both websites will automatically send the credit to the Real Estate Commission, so you don't need to contact the REC about it. You can check the PSI Database 24 hours later to confirm your record.
